



Extensive Grape Variety Collection

Amateur horticulturists in all parts of the country will be interested in the large collection of grape varieties maintained by the Schroeder Vineyard of Hutchinson, Kansas. This vineyard is a privately owned experimental planting established to provide information on, and propagating material of, many of the fine old and new varieties. Special attention is given to the French-American hybrid types.

A list of varieties was recently released by the Schroeder Vineyards and includes 429 different grapes of the following types.

The operators of this collection sell cuttings as well as rooted plants. They also graft and sell named varieties on vigorous rootstocks. In many instances such grafted vines have produced 20 to 40 percent more fruit than the same variety on its own roots.
