

New Editor for Fruit Varieties

Beginning with the next issue of FRUIT VARIETIES AND HORTICULTURAL DIGEST, Mr. J. C. McDaniel, State Horticulturist of the Tennessee Department of Agriculture will become Editor of this publication. For the four years during which this magazine has been published, Dr. Wesley P. Judkins of the Ohio Agricultural Experiment Station has served as Editor. He is now leaving Ohio to become Head of the Department of Horticulture at Virginia Polytechnic Institute and feels he will not have time to continue with this work when he assumes his new responsibilities.

Mr. McDaniel has a very unique horticultural background. Growing up in the fruit district of northern Alabama, he attended College at Auburn and the University of Tennessee. Serving first with T. V. A. and later the Michigan Experiment Station and U. S. Soil Conservation Service, he worked with plant materials of all kinds. His familiarity with fruit and nut varieties is outstanding among American Horticulturists. Mr. McDaniel has also had a wide and varied experience serving as Editor of TENNESSEE HORTICULTURE and THE NUT-SHELL, a new nut growers journal.

Besides his position as State Horticulturist of Tennessee, Mr. McDaniel is Secretary of the Northern Nut Growers Association. He already has a large following of interested readers and we look forward to a large expansion in his service to the fruit industry.
