

Annual Meeting of

A. P. S. Set for

February 21 - 22

The next annual meeting of the American Pomological Society will be held in St. Louis, Missouri on February 21-22, 1951. Headquarters will be in the Chase Hotel where adequate facilities for all needs have been reserved.

A new and interesting arrangement has been worked out for the 1951 meeting. While not meeting jointly with a State Horticultural Society as has often been the plan, our annual meeting will overlap that of the National Peach Council. In other words the two organizations will have a day's joint session on February 21, at which time the program will be devoted almost entirely to peach production and marketing problems. The question of peach varieties will also be featured in a discussion panel on which all parts of the country will be represented.

On the evening of February 21 we will have the annual banquet of our Society, with leading officers of the Na-

tional Peach Council as our guests. At this banquet there will be many interesting features including first hand reports from Europe. Here also will be scheduled the awarding of Wilder medals in token of valuable horticultural services, especially in the field of variety improvement.

The following day's program will be given over to fruits other than peaches. Here, too, we will have featured speakers from all parts of the country including the Pacific Northwest. Altogether, it will be a feast of horticultural information from a national viewpoint.

Detailed information on the program will reach A. P. S. members by letter and in horticultural periodicals. Secure your hotel reservations now and plan to make this one of the best American Pomological Society meetings of all time!
