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Winter Hardiness of Raspberries in Poland

Polish horticulturists of the Prace Instytutu Sadownictwa have reported in 1958 on a hardiness test of red raspberries which included the varie-

ties Indian Summer, Latham, Lloyd George, Newburgh, Malling Promise and Malling Seedling. It appears that Malling Promise were severely injured by winter temperatures. Malling Seedling showed the least injury, and the others were intermediate.
