

Sources of Propagating Wood for Plum Cultivars, Species, and Species Hybrids in the United States and Canada

The included list of sources of propagating wood for plum cultivars (varieties), species and species hybrids is the fifth in a series of such lists. Previous lists were published in this journal as follows:

1. Apples—9(3): 38-48. 1954
2. Pears—11(1): 6-15. 1956
3. Peaches and nectarines—13(1): 6-16. 1958.
4. Cherries—16(1): 2-11. 1961.

The present list was compiled from responses to a questionnaire sent to all experiment stations and to several private plum breeders and variety testers. The Committee accepts responsibility for editing these responses in the interest of obtaining uniformity and accuracy. Reciprocal crosses are combined in this listing. In some cases the classification of cultivars is of necessity arbitrary.

The more common synonyms, if known, are indicated in parentheses. Likewise, plant patents (if still in effect) and other propagation restrictions are noted in parentheses. The indicated restrictions are to be respected in all requests for propagating wood.

Plant Introduction (P.I.) numbers of the U. S. Department of Agriculture are given where applicable to specific collections. All other number or letter designations, or names (where not a synonym) following a variety or species, refer to collections maintained as distinct entities because of apparent freedom from virus, reputed high production, or other desirable characteristics.

An asterisk (*) is used to denote collections presently under yellowbud virus quarantine. These are included because they represent a potential source of material and their inclusion presents a true picture of the extensive plum collection at that particular location.

A. N. Wilcox, Fruit Breeder, Dies

A. N. Wilcox, director of the fruit breeding work at the University Fruit Breeding Farm of the University of Minnesota, at Excelsior since 1953, died February 26, 1963, at the age of 64.

Born in Waterloo, Wisconsin in 1898, Dr. Wilcox did his undergraduate work at the University of Wisconsin, and took his graduate degree at the University of Minnesota. He was on the staff at Minnesota for 40 years, until his death. He was the first to in-breed strawberries to develop improved varieties; and he introduced, through the University, the Earlimore and Trumpeter strawberries, and the Moongold and Sungold apricots.
