**Which Red Sports of Delicious Are Best?**

In the Proceedings of the 1963 meeting of the N. Y. State Hort. Society, John Einset and Roger Way discuss the Delicious red sports. They point out that the sports vary in when coloring begins, type of color development, and final color, and that these factors vary with location and season. They also report that pressure testing of 15 sports at Geneva do not substantiate the claim that some are earlier or later maturing than standard Delicious.

The sports that have looked best at Geneva are: Of the standard tree sports—Imperial, Red Wenatchee, Royal Red and Starking, for the dark red type; Hi Red, Richared, Vance, for the light red. Of the spur types, Red-spur was the most impressive dark red, and Okanoma is the light red that looked good.
