Dr. Walter D. Weeks

Dr. Walter D. Weeks, of the Department of Plant and Soil Sciences, of the University of Massachusetts at Amherst, died July 25, 1968. He was known for his research on nutrition, rootstocks, varieties and responses to growth regulators of fruit crops.

Dr. Weeks received his B.S. and M.S. degrees from University of New Hampshire, and his Ph.D. from University of Massachusetts. He had been on the faculty of the latter institution since 1945. For several years he was chairman of the A. P. S. Committee for True-to-Name Nursery Inspection.
